46	Astley Village Parish Council	<p>Land which runs along Westway, down along Chancery Road and along Southport Road is identified as Amenity Greenspace</p> <p>This land is not suitable for informal activities such as picnics, playing games or kids play etc – although it does enhance the appearance of the area.</p> <p>This land is better suited to be allocated to be ‘Green Corridor’ as you can walk alongside it, or through it in some parts, also there is a cycle path beside some of it. It is suitable for leisure walking and travelling to/from Astley Village and has lots of opportunity for wildlife in the woods.</p> <p>Astley Village Parish Council requests the allocation of this land is changed to ‘Green Corridor’</p>	<p>The land typologies that are in the open space strategy are already established and can't be altered to an alternative typology.</p> <p>The best fit typology was chosen at the time of assessment, the amenity space referred to is classed as Amenity Greenspace. It provides visual amenity to the area.</p> <p>This area of land is ultimately protected from development. It would not be changed to Green Corridor.</p>	-
