# INTRODUCING CHORLEY YOUTH ZONE

**OnSide Youth Zones** 





- Founded in 2008
- To replicate the successful model of Bolton Lads
  & Girls Club in disadvantaged areas of the UK
- Strong Private Sector Led Governance
- Chorley will be the 9<sup>th</sup> Youth Zone in the OnSide network
- A target of 20 live projects by 2020
- A growing charity now expanding into London



# YOUTH ZONE OFFER







- 20 activities each night
- Buildings that create involvement
- Sports, arts, personal development
- Expert staff & an army of volunteers

- Employability and enterprise
- Try, train, team approach
- Inclusive

- Second home for young people
- Raise aspirations



### WHAT IS A YOUTH ZONE?







- A safe, supportive & inspiring space
- Quality provision for all young people, regardless of ability
- Providing support for young people in deprived areas
- For young people aged 8-19 or up to 25 for those with a disability
- Affordable; 50p per visit & £5 annual membership
- Open when schools are closed, all day weekends & during school holidays

### IMPACT FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

- 70% of members exercise regularly each week
- 80% get better marks in their school work
- 89% reported feeling more selfconfident as a result of attending a Youth Zone
- 76% have improved relationships within their family
- 80% of members are thinking about life after school and further education



### **COMMUNITY IMPACT**

"Over the past 2 ½ years since The Factory opened we feel that the area [Harpurhey] is no longer filled with youths on the streets with nothing to do.

Before the Youth Zone opened young people would create their own entertainment usually ASB, including low level crimes such as; drinking on the street, throwing stones, off road bikes, setting fires."

- Have a membership of c. 2,000 young people, from across all areas of Chorley
- Create 50 jobs
- Recruit over 100 volunteers
- Significantly reduce ASB in the area, providing a platform for the whole community to work together
- Improve perceptions of young people in the community
- Support young people to be fit for work and fit for life


CHORLEY YOUTH ZONE
