Hi Nathan, I've attached the notice of actions requesting remote access, the unredacted case summary for the only noise complaint we have received regarding the premises and an email from Leanne Carey in Council Tax on 26th June confirming that all 6 flats (6-10A) above the shops at Hallgate are currently occupied.

The noise complaint was received on 30th January 2020 and Neil Kirkham sent our initial standard letter to the complainant on 31st January which asks them to read the information and come back to us within 14 days if they want to proceed with the complaint. Neil visited Mrs Boyd, the owner of the business on 6th February with Carl Gore and the complaint was closed on 9th March 2020 after no further contact was received from the complainant. As the complaint did not proceed beyond the initial stage, we have no nuisance record sheets and no evidence from the installation of a noise recorder.

I visited the site this morning and it's not entirely clear which properties have part of their floor space immediately above Little Inn on the Park although looking at a plan it appears that Flats 6, 7, 8 and 9 will be above Little Inn on the Park while 10 and 10A may be above McColls so I'd consider at least 4 properties to be in the vicinity.
