ADDENDUM

The following additional information is brought forward for members' information with regard to items on the Committee this evening:

<u>Item A2: 05/888</u> – Additional letter of support from a resident on Preston Road stating that prior to the applicant's involvement in the site there was no available access to the rear of his property while the land needed development; with the parking now proposed the writer wishes to fully support the proposal.

<u>Item B3: 05/00976</u> – A letter has been received from the applicant, raising the following points in support of the application:

- The footpath adjacent to the house is a busy walkway with numerous school children and adults using it from 7.30 onwards;
- The time when children would be being dropped off is when residents are making their way to work also (childminding would start at 8am);
- Having another adult at the premises would help keep the noise levels at a minimum;
- Many of the neighbours have a number of vehicles visiting during the day;
- It is intended that the front garden would be paved over once the childminding business starts;
- Many of the neighbours do not object to the proposals.

<u>Item B4: 05/01042</u>- Additional letter of objection from a resident on Chapel Lane raising the following objections:

- Will be sited only a few feet away from the properties on Chapel Lane
- Questions why the masts can't be placed on the opposite side of the site near the railway line or near the graveyard.
