Productivity Plan

Councillor Alistair Bradley, Executive Leader, presented the report of the Deputy Chief Executive which sought the endorsement of the Executive Cabinet for the Chorley Productivity Plan to be submitted to the Department of Levelling Up, Housing and Communities, as required as part of the last Local Government Financial Settlement.
4. We welcomed the Productivity Plan and approved its submission to the Department of Levelling Up, Housing and Communities.

Property Valuations Tender

5. Councillor Peter Wilson, Deputy Executive Leader presented the confidential report of the Director of Finance which sought approval to undertake a joint procurement exercise, in respect of asset valuation services for the purposes of financial accounts completion and insurance information.
6. We approved the procurement strategy, proposed evaluation criteria and the delegation of authority to the Executive Member (Resources) to award the contract to the successful bidder identified through the procurement process.

Gillett Playing Fields Procurement Methodology

7. Councillor Alistair Morwood, Executive Member for Planning and Development presented the confidential report of the Director of Planning and Property which sought approval for the proposed methodology to procure three elements in relation to improvement works at Gillett Playing Fields.
