- 12 noon Salute to be given as the Parade passes the Civic Party at the Town Hall Main Entrance, Market Street.
- 12.10pm for 12.45pm Reception and Lunch in the Lancastrian Suite, Town Hall.
- 2.30pm (approx) Conclusion of Reception and Lunch
