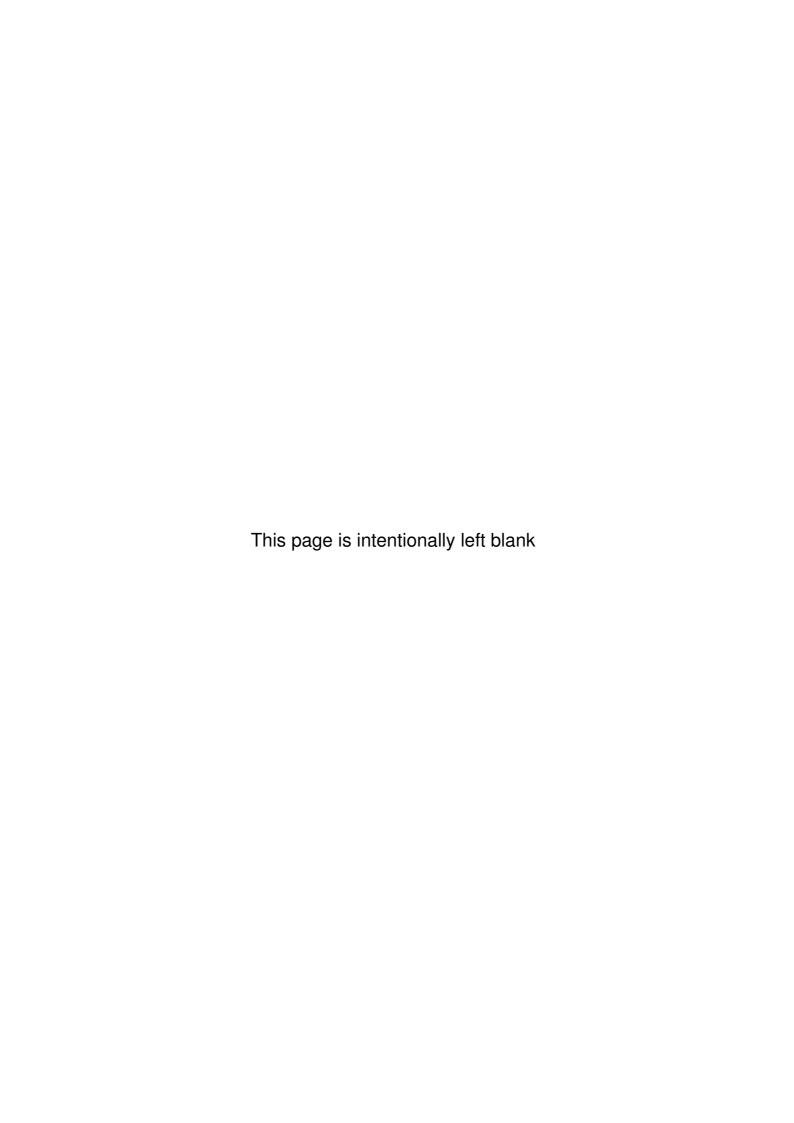

06.SL.29 THE GAMBLING ACT 2005 - APPROVAL OF LICENSING POLICY

Further to Minute 06.SL.17, 19 July 2006 the Committee received a report of the Director of Customer, Democratic and Legal Services requesting the Committee to approve the draft statement of gambling policy and consultation responses prior to the draft version of the policy being presented to the Council for approval.

The report provided further and updated information following the release of regulations and commencement orders by the Government.

The report set out the timetable for implementation indicating that consultation had taken place between 24 July and 13 October 2006. Attached to the report was the analysis of the responses from the consultation.

The timetable provided the following:

- 19 December 2006 Full Council to approve Policy Statement
- 21 December 2006 2 January 2007 Publish Policy Statement

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- 30 April 2007 First appointed day. Transition commenced and Licensing Authority starts receiving application for gambling licences
- 1 September 2007 Second appointed day. Full implementation of Gambling Act 2005.

RESOLVED – That in accordance with Section 39 of the Gambling Act 2005 the responses to the consultation on the draft statement of gambling policy be noted and any amendments to the draft prior to final version be placed before Full Council on 19 December 2006 for approval.

The Gambling Act 2005 fees are required to be set by the 30 April 2007. This is the date 4. which the authority will start to accept Gambling Act applications.

BACKGROUND

- 5. Members may be aware at a previous meeting on 16 May 2006 the Council resolved to amend the Constitution that all the Councils functions under the Gambling act 2005 to the Statutory Licensing Committee in accordance with section 154 Gambling Act except:
 - i) The approval of a Statement of Licensing Policy under section 349 of the act.
 - ii) Resolving whether to issue any Casino Licence in the Borough of Chorley Under section 166 of the Act.
 - iii) The setting of fees for licences.
- Responsibility for setting fees under the Gambling Act 2005 falls to the Full Council. 6. Section 154 (2)(b) allows Full Council to delegate responsibility to the appropriate Committee or an individual person.
- 7. It is to be recommended at full Council on 23 January 2007 that the setting of the Gambling Act 2005 fees be delegated to the Statutory Licensing Committee.
