APPLICATION FOR THE RENEWAL OF A SEX ESTABLISHMENT LICENCE

PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. To enable Members to determine an application to renew the sex establishment licence for premises known/trading as 'M & M Sensations'.

2. There are no specific implications arising from this report

4. There is a right of appeal against the decision of this Committee to the Magistrates Court.

BACKGROUND

- 5. An application to renew the sex establishment licence has been received in respect of these premises situated on Bolton Road, Chorley. The premises have had the benefit of a sex establishment licence since 22 August 2002.
- 6. In accordance with the requirements of paragraphs 9(7)-(10) of schedule 3 to the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982, the applicant has advertised the application in the local press and on the application premises, within the statutory time limits.

CURRENT POSITION

7. The local police have been consulted and their views sought. They have responded by saying that they have no objection to the renewal of the licence.

- 8. The Council's Environmental Services Unit have been consulted and have no comments to make relating to this application.
- 9. The fire service have stated that they have no concerns regarding this application.
- 10. The Licensing Enforcement Officer has confirmed that there have been no enforcement issues with these premises.
- 11. A petition has been received signed by 90 objectors. The petition is on the basis that the undersigned 'object to the renewal of the licence for a sex shop at 75a Bolton Street, Chorley. We have concerns about preserving and protecting wholesome family values. As far as we are concerned, this business is sleazy and promotes an entirely wrong image of Chorley.' The petition will be circulated at the meeting. All objectors have been invited to attend the meeting.

LEGAL POSITION

- 12. The Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 provides that an application for the renewal of a licence may be refused on a number of grounds:
 - i) that the applicant is unsuitable to hold a licence by reason of having been convicted of an offence or any other reason;
 - ii) that if the licence were renewed the business to which it relates would be managed or carried on for the benefit of a person, other than the applicant, who would be refused the grant, renewal or transfer of such a licence if they made the application himself;
 - iii) That the number of sex establishments in the relevant locality at the time the application is made is equal to or exceeds the number which the authority considered appropriate for that locality;
 - iv) The renewal of the licence would be inappropriate, having regard -
 - to the character of the relevant locality
 - to the use to which any premises in the vicinity are put: or
 - to the layout, character, condition of the premises in respect of which the application is made.
- 13. This Authority resolved on 4 September 2002 the following:

"This Authority will not normally grant a sex establishment licence sought to be established in the Borough within a distance of 2.5 miles from an existing sex establishment calculated as the crow flies. That as part of this policy account should be taken of existing licences in local authority areas that immediately border the Borough boundary".

In terms of the application before the Committee there are no premises within the criteria mentioned above.
