



Guidance for Members on using Council car parks

Members of the Council are permitted to park their vehicles free of charge on the Council car parks in Chorley when they are visiting Council buildings or attending events for any purpose associated with Council activities.

Members are requested to provide the details of their vehicle registration number to Democratic Services who will set up the electronic car parking permit. No paper passes are issued, as car parking attendants use number plate recognition technology to check whether vehicles are authorised to park.

Please notify the Democratic Services Section if you change your vehicle as they will need to update your electronic car parking permit.

Which car parks can you use and for how long?

Long stay car parks you can park all day

Water Street
Queens Road
Friday Street
George Street
Farrington Street and Back Mount
Fleet Street (Long Stay side)

Short stay car parks you can park for a maximum of three hours with no return within 2 hours

West Street
St Mary's
Fleet Street (Short Stay side)
Hollinshead Street
Cleveland Street

There are no 'Mixed stay car parks'.

Please note you are not authorised to park on the Flat Iron or designated residents parking within Chorley.
