# SUBSIDISED BUS SERVICES – CONTINUTION OF FUNDING FOR 2019/20 AND AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING ROUTES

#### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- To seek approval for the continuation of funding for the Chorley Council subsided bus service contracts for a 12-month period from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019 – 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020.
- 2. To outline proposed amendments to the existing Chorley Council subsided services to partially replace the withdrawn commercial daytime 109A service.

#### **RECOMMENDATION(S)**

3. To seek approval for continuation of funding of £65,731 for the Chorley Council subsidised bus contracts for a 12-month period from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019 - 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF REPORT**

- 4. In June 2018, Chorley Council approved funding to subsidise the 357 service and the 109B/24A evening and weekend service for 12 months from Monday 3 September to Saturday 31 August.
- 5. The daytime 109A has been withdrawn by Stagecoach due to a lack of commercial viability.
- 6. The report contains the proposals put forward by LCC to amend existing services to maintain provision across the existing subsidised routes and incorporate aspects of the withdrawn 109A. The 24A service will remain unchanged.
- 7. The cost implications of these reconfigured routes are detailed within this report.

#### REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION(S)

#### (If the recommendations are accepted)

8. For Chorley Council to fund these services for a 12-month period will allow these bus services to continue for the benefit of Chorley residents.

#### ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

9. To withdraw the subsidy – this was rejected as it would leave parts of the borough on the routes with restricted services.

#### **BACKGROUND**

- 11. At present, Chorley Council currently provide a contribution towards the delivery of the 357 and 109B/24A services. LCC provide 40% funding towards the cost of these services and Chorley Council provides 60%. This approximately costs the Council £93,416 per annum. This was agreed through an Executive Member decision and funding was committed towards these services for a 12-month period from Monday 3 September 2018 Saturday 31 August 2019.
- 12. In July 2019 Stagecoach announced they would be withdrawing the entire 109A service and this would be effective from 22 July as it was deemed no longer a commercially viable service. LCC provided local bus operators with passenger numbers and operational details however none came forward to operate this service on a commercial basis.
- 13. Following this, LCC explored options for the authority to fund a replacement service, however it was decided that this was not financially viable given budget constraints at County.

14. LCC approached Chorley Council with a proposition for replacing the 109A. This included reconfiguring existing services to deliver a replacement for the 109A within existing resources. This proposal affects existing Chorley Council funded services; the 109B and 357. This report outlines the proposed route amends and cost implications.

#### PROPOSED SERVICE AMENDMENTS

- 15. The proposed amends revise the existing services 357 and 109B to partially replace the 109A provision. The 24A service remains unchanged.
- 16. These revisions will be contained under appropriate contract variations with the existing service providers, therefore these amends will not prompt going back out to tender. The current contract end dates continue to be 27 March 2021, although the contract has a notice period of 12 weeks, which can be activated by either operator or local authority.
- 17. It should be noted that the original proposal by LCC for the 119 route was to run this service from the town centre via Chorley Hospital and into Astley Village. Chorley Council proposed to also include provision along Southport Road, extending the circular route proposed. However, LCC deemed this not possible given the sharing of vehicles with the 118 service; therefore it was agreed to run the service via Southport Road as opposed to the Hospital due to the vital amenities along Southport Road.

#### 118/119

- 18. The existing Chorley Council subsidised 357 service which serves Chorley and Lower Burgh will be withdrawn and reconfigured to provide two new services, the 118 and 119 which each partially replace the 357 service and include a link to Astley Village in place of the withdrawn 109A.
- The 118 is a circular route which runs from Chorley Interchange via Collingwood Rd -Pilling Lane – Weld Bank Carr Lane - Eaves Green Rd - Collingwood Rd back through to Chorley Interchange.
- 20. The 119 is a circular route which runs from Chorley Interchange via Southport Road Astley Village Chancery Road back through to Chorley Interchange. The service will operate generally every hour during Monday to Saturday daytime.
- 21. To ensure commonality and to avoid customer confusion, the Monday to Saturday evening and Sunday Service 109B will be renumbered to operate as Service 119, on the same route as the daytime service, with the Sunday daytime additionally serving Tesco.
- 22. The revisions mean that some areas, Lower Burgh and Gillibrands, will now receive a bus service every 2 hours rather than every hour, however this compromise is considered necessary to maintain provision and ensure the continuation of a service to the larger population of Astley Village.

#### 337/347

23. There will be minor changes to the 337 service from Chorley to Ormskirk and 347 service from Chorley to Southport to ensure these routes link in well with the other

services. These will pick up some of the areas previously covered by the 357. These routes are not currently funded by Chorley Council.

#### 24A

24. The 24A service remains unchanged.

#### **COST IMPLICATIONS**

#### **Proposed position**

- 26. With the changes to these services, it is projected that Chorley Council's contribution towards tendered bus services will be reduced by £27,000 and LCC's contribution will be marginally increased by £5,000.
- 27. The table below demonstrates actual breakdown of the estimated cost changes:

- 28. As demonstrated above there are changes to the contribution splits between LCC and Chorley Council. It is proposed that the Monday to Saturday daytime service is cost shared with LCC contributing 75% and Chorley Council contributing 25% and the evening and Sunday service is cost shared with LCC contributing 25% and Chorley Council contributing 75%.
- 29. All costs are approximate and are dependent upon the current known cost of the services and the amount of revenue (including concessions) generated and therefore may fluctuate across the period of the contract.

30. It is proposed that Chorley Council's contribution will be reduced by approximately £27k.

32. Chorley Council currently has £85k in budget for bus services so for a full year the proposal would give a £19k budget saving. The saving in 19/20 would be approximately £10k.
