

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257

CHORLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL (PART OF FOOTPATH 58 COPPULL AND PART OF FOOTPATH ADLINGTON 13) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019

This order is made by Chorley Borough Council under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the sections of footpath to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely: Planning Permission 18/00843/FULMAJ for the construction of a dairy unit and associated infrastructure on land east of Wigan Lane Chorley

BY THIS ORDER:

1 Part of Footpath Coppull 58 and Footpath Adlington 13 over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part I of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted as provided below.

2 There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Chorley Borough Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said sections of footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.

3 The diversion of the sections of footpath shall have effect on the date on which Chorley Borough Council certify that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with.

4. The following works shall be carried out in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the schedule:

(i) Provision of a compacted stone surface as necessary; stone ranging from 2 cm to dust

(ii) Such other works as may be notified to the applicant J & B Woodcock & Sons following inspection by Lancashire County Council

5. J & B Woodcock & Sons are hereby required to pay for the cost of carrying out the said works.

6 Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
