April 2019:

Work undertaken to improve the kitchen facilities in the café.



April 2019:

Clayton Brook Residents Group was officially formed with the group signing a constitution and creating a group bank account.

This enabled the group to receive 2 Councillor grants for 2 different projects – one for community events, and one for the community café.

## May

May 2019:

Children & Family Wellbeing Service held a Triple P course for parents who need support communicating with their children.

## June

June 2019:

Emergency First Aid at Work held at the village hall for residents and volunteers.

A handful of residents have also been trained in food hygiene level 2 to enable them to be able to volunteer in the café.

## July

July - Sept 2019:

The residents group ran a community café each Wednesday over the summer holidays to enable families to socialise.



## August

August 2019:

Positive Together sessions have finished, after engaging with approximately 40 different local young people, with over 300 attendances.

September 2019:

Emerging Futures, New You and CGL launch The Wellbeing Hub at Clayton Brook Village Hall – providing support for anyone affected by drugs and alcohol.

Sept 2019:

The residents group held a Macmillan Coffee morning at the village hall with a visit from the MP and local school, which raised over £300



## September

September 2019:

The resident's group and other residents came together to improve the central area of Clayton Brook including the planters in front of the village hall, which have now been assigned to the group for future projects. Pictures below.
