Eastern Parishes	Increased defibrillator provision in Withnell and Wheelton	Installation of public access defibrillator in Withnell	<p>Complete</p> <p>A public access defibrillator has now been installed at Withnell Pharmacy. The owner has agreed to fund ongoing electricity costs and staff within the pharmacy will carry out the required weekly checks.</p> <p>Withnell Parish Council have agreed to fund the replacement batteries and pads when required.</p> <p>A Community Awareness session will be being delivered soon.</p>
	Creation of Civic Pride Entrance Stone at Heapey Chase Estate	To install entrance stone at Heapey Chase estate on junction with Heapey Road and Kittawake	<p>In Progress</p> <p>Site identified on grass verge at junction with Kittiwake Road and Heapey Road. It has been agreed that it will be Stone feature with text 'Heapey Chase', placed within a raised planter type decoration.</p> <p>Local providers have been identified for creation and due to be confirmed soon with the Parish Council.</p> <p>Land owner Persimmon Homes has given permissions in principle for the stone to be installed</p> <p>Heapey Parish Council have agreed to be responsible for ongoing maintenance of plants etc at the feature.</p>
