Closes: Friday 14 February 2020

- All stakeholders including Parish Councils and the public are being engaged in accordance with the Statement of Community Involvement
- Elected Members and Parish Councils are being consulted on all published proposals at the relevant stage

- We need your help to make sure we have a plan for Central Lancashire that creates good quality places to live, work and relax over the next 15 years to 2036
- We need you to tell us how we can improve our area for future generations and reduce the impacts of climate change by being carbon neutral by 2030
- The Annexes show the sites received for the area through Call for Sites 1 and 2 consultations
- We are seeking your views on the Council's proposed list of site suggestions in principle for Chorley

Memorandum of Understanding & 5 year housing supply

- Draft MOU has been prepared on the basis of the new housing distribution
- Consultation closed on Monday 13th January
- MOU reviewed annually until new plan adopted to address Office of National Statistics updates or methodology changes which could affect the Local Housing Need
- The requirement under the MOU for Chorley is 282 rather than 579 under standard method. 282 will be the figure CBC use for assessing 5yr housing supply.
- Using this figure the 5 yr supply for Chorley is 6.6 yrs

Housing numbers and distribution across Central Lancashire

- Under Standard Housing Method, the combined housing figure for CL is 1,026 dwellings per annum.
- The 3 Councils have agreed the following distribution of this figure
 - Preston 40% = 410 dpa
 - South Ribble 32.5 % = 334 dpa
 - Chorley 27.5% = 282 dpa
