I am writing regarding the recreational ground that has been built behind these properties and to raise several issues that have supposed to have been addressed and issues to do with the safety of my children and all children who play on this park.

Since the building starting on this park last October we have encountered numerous problems. Large lorries gained access down the side of my property bumping into lower fence and cracking the concrete slabs holding the fence up I reported this several times to yourself and the construction workers and was assured that it would be fixed this fence is so unsafe and has not been fixed I was also told that the side of my house would be fully barmaced and this has also been left uncompleted. People are going down the side of my property and throwing stone which we have done damage to our cars and the properties. The people who did the work have now left the site but we all feel that the park is still a serious hazard and danger to our children. There has been no landscaping done or rock tidying up of the site and there are still lots of rottable peats are now throwing this rottable. and

causing damage and disturbance to our Gardens and properties.

There are no safety access routes to the park as cars and motorbikes can still drive on there, this is dangerous to all our children playing on there. I feel that a kissing gate should be in operation at all access routes to try and eliminate this danger.

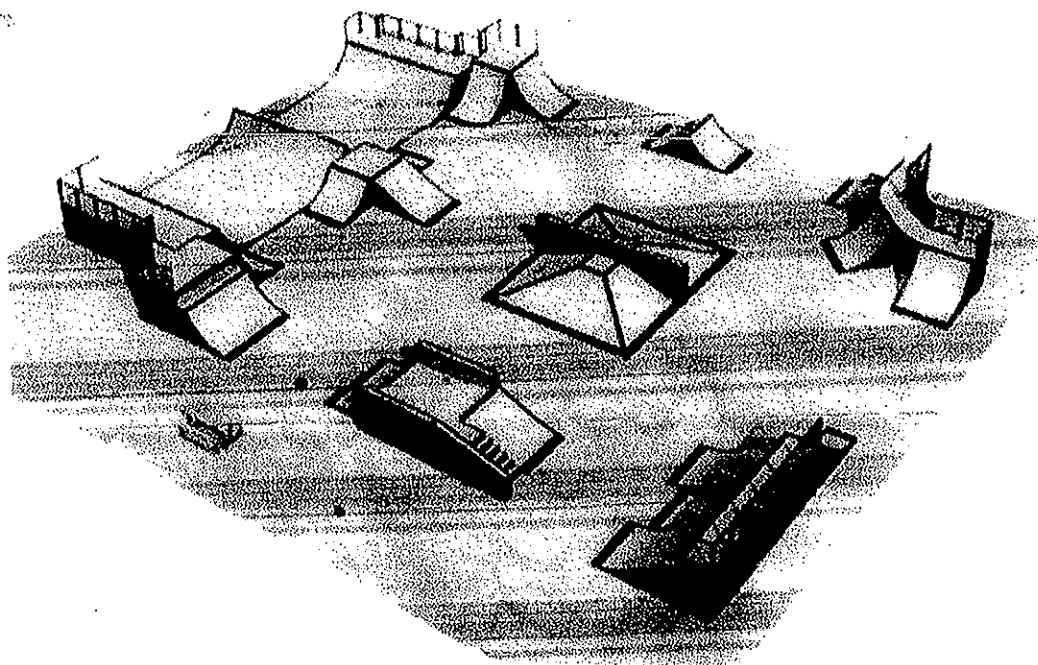
My fence remains unrepaired and a serious safety and security issue for my family and house. I was told it would be fixed twelve months ago and this has not happened. I have contacted you on numerous times about the park etc and had not much response.

Also now at night teenagers are on there drinking and generally causing a public nuisance it has now started to affect me and my family especially my disabled daughter with epilepsy as her room is at the back of the house and people are so noisy that she is unable to sleep or gets woken that they can cause her to have seizures. I feel that something should be done about moving these people off at night by 9pm, there is no lighting or security on this park and I now dread nights coming and feel unsafe in my own property. please could I have response to this issues as soon as possible.

The Community House on Liptrott Road Chorley was originally provided over two years ago, by CCH as a temporary meeting place whilst the Community Centre was being built.

The house has become a popular meeting place for several organisations during this period for detached base provisions i.e. Baby Weighing, Duke Street detached toddler team, Positive Action for Young People (PAYP), Age Concern, Time Banking Volunteers, Youth Services Detached Team, Time Bank Youth Group and ourselves the Chorley Moor Residents Group.

Some time ago it became apparent that the building was too small for our needs, we are now in the situation where this is affecting all the groups, through restricting activities. An example of which is our own monthly resident meeting, which is increasing in numbers and becoming difficult to hold in the limited space within the house.

There are a lot of activities that the local residents wish to be involved and organise, however until we have our Community Centre we will not have the facilities in which to carry out these activities. These include things for all members of the community: -

- Luncheon Clubs
- Bingo for all age groups
- Dance classes
- Indoor sports
- Mother and Toddler groups
- Advice and Information provisions
- Adequate meeting provisions
- Computer access and Basic skill classes
- Weekly Youth Group provisions for all ages
- Eating on a Budget programmes and Healthy options
