ANNEX 1 – MANDATORY CONDITIONS

MANDATORY DRINKS CODE

Section 19:

The Premises licence holder shall ensure that no supply of alcohol is made under the premises licence - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence; or (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended (section 19 of the Licensing Act 2003).

The Premises licence holder shall ensure that every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence (section 19 of the Licensing Act 2003).

ALCOHOL PROMOTIONS

(1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

(2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children -

(a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to -
(i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
(ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

(b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in Section 159 of the Act);

(c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;

(d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on -

(i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
(ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;

(e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

DISPENSING ALCOHOL

The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

FREE TAP WATER

The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

AGE VERIFICATION

- (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

ALCOHOL MEASURES

The responsible person shall ensure that-

- (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-
- (i) beer or cider: 1/2 pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
- (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

DOOR SUPERVISORS

The Premises licence holder shall ensure that each individual present on the premises to carry out a security activity [as defined by paragraph 2(1) (a) of the Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001] must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

ANNEX 2 – CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

Note – Some conditions may apply to one or more of the objectives

General

1. In accordance with Annex 1, Condition 6 (1), there shall be a challenge 25 age policy in place.
 - i. All challenges and outcomes will be entered into a refusal log which will be made available to a Police Officer or authorised officer of the Council upon reasonable request.

Prevention of Crime and Disorder

2. The premises shall operate and maintain a CCTV system which shall be in use during all times that licensable activities are taking place at the premises.
 - i. The system shall cover the entrance to and exit from the premises in addition to covering areas of the premises used to store and supply licensed products.
 - a. The focus of the camera(s) shall be so as to enable clear identification of persons on the premises.
 - ii. The system shall also be capable of time and date stamping recordings and retaining said recordings for a period of not less than 21 days.

- iii. The Data Controller shall make footage available to a Police Constable or Authorised Officer, where such request is made in accordance with and which satisfies the Data Protection Act 1998.
- iv. The premises licence holder or representative there of shall inform the Licensing Unit of any malfunction within the operation of the system upon detection or as soon as is practical thereafter, in any event within a period of 96 hours of detection.
- v. If pubwatch scheme available would attend.

Public Safety

- 3. The Premises licence holder or representative thereof shall enforce a zero tolerance policy towards the supply or use of illegal drugs on the premises.
 - i. Where it is suspected that a patron is using or supplying illegal drugs on the premises, the details shall be recorded and passed on to the Police.
 - a. Details to be passed to the Police includes, time and date of suspected activities along with a description of those involved, where possible CCTV footage should also be supplied.

Prevention of Public Nuisance

- 4. The Premises licence holder or representative thereof will be a member of, and attend local Pub-watch meetings, where one exists and comply with the decisions of the group regarding patrons to be excluded from licensed premises within the area.
- 5. Signs are positioned at all exits requesting patrons leave the area in a quiet and orderly manner when leaving the premises.
- 6. All windows and doors will be kept closed whilst regulated entertainment is taking place except to allow for access and egress.
 - i. The premises licence holder or representative thereof will conduct an assessment of noise from the boundary of the premises whilst regulated entertainment is taking place.
 - ii. Noise from the premises shall not exceed ambient background noise at the boundary.
 - a. Where noise from the premises exceeds ambient background noise at the boundary of the premises, steps shall be taken to reduce the volume accordingly.
 - iii. Assessments shall be recorded in an incident log and made available to a Police Officer or authorised Officer of the Council upon reasonable request.

Protection of Children From Harm

- 7. Children under the age of 18 are to be accompanied by an adult whilst licensable activities are taking place on the premises.

Anyone who seems under 25 shall be I.D.'d

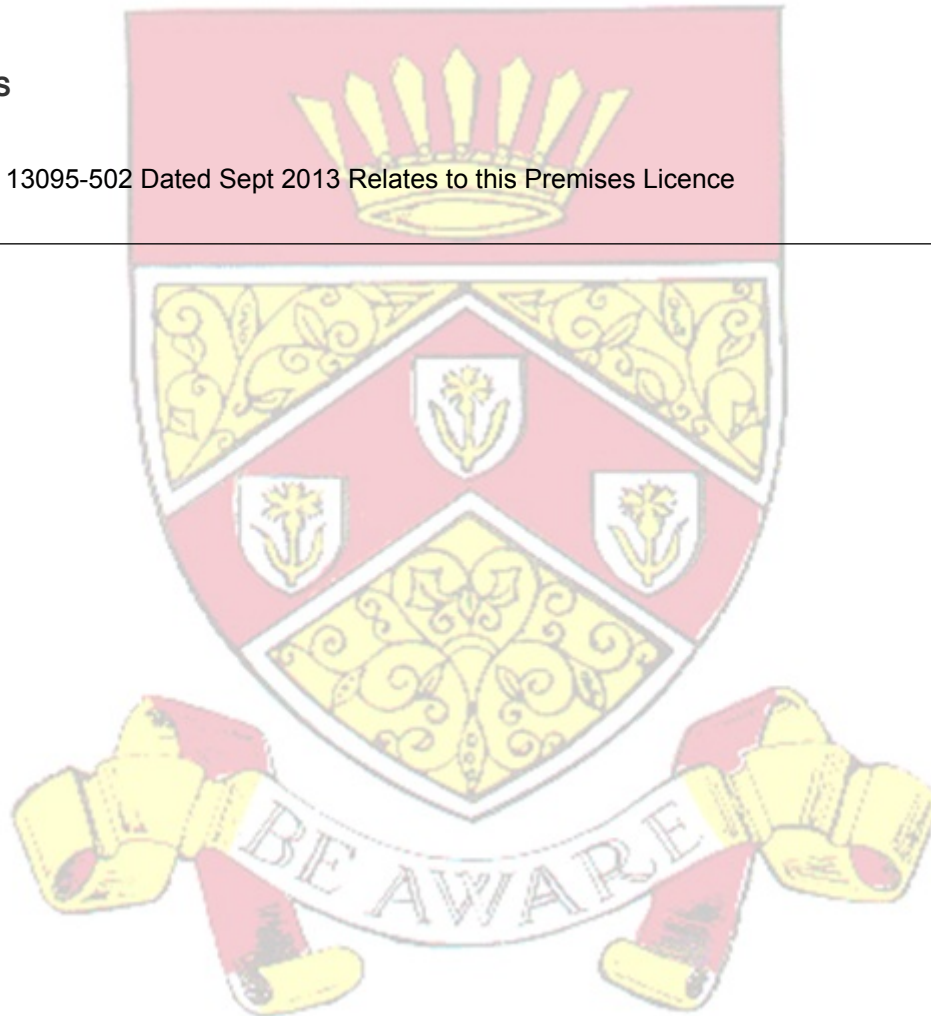
