I have had a letter from Councillor Whittaker showing that there building going up on Camelot . I am local resident living at the top of Park Hall Road. I am exceptionally troubled about the traffic and object to this Licensing Application for the following reasons:-

1. Our area is a quiet residential area and the potential noise from the films and more importantly the "recorded and live music and dance" / concerts, that will be allowed to 23.00, is highly likely to be very disrupted to our common law rights to peace and quiet.
2. The proposal to allow the "supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises" will only add to a likely public nuisance from any drunken behaviour of the customers see pictures of drink driving..
3. It is understood that there could be up to 3 showings of films / music events in any day with up to 200 cars being allowed access. As each car could hold up to 5 persons that is circa 1,000 people attending any event, which will obviously develop into a party atmosphere.
