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Purpose of the Report

1. A To allocate places on the various committees of the Council in accordance with Section 15 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 and to make appointments to those committees in accordance with Section 16 of the Act, together with the appointment of the Chairs and Vice Chairs of the appropriate Committees.

Recommendations

2. The allocation of committee places in accordance with the Political Balance Rules as set out in the report be approved.
3. The Members, Chairs and Vice Chairs for the committees set out in the appendix to this report be appointed for the period of twelve months until the first business meeting of the Council in May 2025.
4. To note the Shadow Cabinet appointments for this municipal year.

Background to the report

6. Under the terms of Section 15 (5) of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989, where a Council is divided into different political groups in accordance with the Local Government (Committees and Political Groups) Regulations 1990 as this Council is, seats on ordinary committees have to be allocated to give effect to the following principles:
- (a) all the seats on committees are not to be allocated to the same political group
 - (b) the majority of seats on a committee should be allocated to the group which has the majority of the Authority's membership
 - (c) subject to (a) and (b) above, the total number of seats on committees must be allocated in proportion to the political strength on the Council and
 - (d) subject to (a), (b) and (c) above, the number of seats on each committee must be allocated in proportion to the political strength on the Council.

Political composition

7. The current political composition of the Council is:

8. In order to comply with Section 15 (5) of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 and the Local Government (Committees and Political Groups) Regulations 1990, the allocation of seats on committees is set out below:
