PLANNNING APPEALS LODGED

Appeal by Baxter Estates Ltd against the refusal of planning permission for development of 164 residential dwellings including landscaping, access off Froom Street, and highway improvements to Froom Street/Eaves Lane at Talbot Mill, Froom Street, Chorley (Application No 05/00344/FULMAJ)

Appeal by Mr and Mrs Mee against the refusal of planning permission for the erection of a single storey replacement outbuilding to form self-contained living accommodation ancillary to the main building at 185 South Street, Bretherton (Application No 05/00534/FUL)

Appeal by Mr and Mrs Kirkman against the refusal of planning permission for a revised house type for replacement dwelling at 97 Rawlinson Lane, Heath Carnock (Application No 05/01048/FUL)

Appeal by Mr A Mason against an enforcement notice issued for a breach of planning control, namely the change of use of the land and building to a mixed use for the repair of motor vehicles and as an operating base for taxis at 21 Gorsey Lane, Mawdesley (EN 598).
