 - Members training at South Ribble (Autumn tbc)
 - Draft statement of principles to be amended and prepared for approval by Statutory Licensing Committee and Full Council Autumn.
 - Final statement of principles available at least one month prior to 31/1/07.
 - 31/1/07 Authority will accept applications for licenses and permits.
