



HOUSEHOLDER DESIGN GUIDANCE SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT JANUARY 2017

Chorley Council has produced a Householder Design Guidance Supplementary Planning Document (SPD). This SPD was adopted by Chorley Council following approval of adoption by the Council meeting on 24 January 2017.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of this SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD.

Any such application for leave to review the decision must be made promptly and in any case not later than three months after the date on which this Adoption Statement was published – that is by 19 April 2017.
