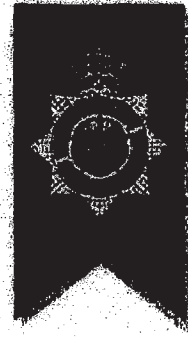

I refer to the variation of the licence at the above premises (in the Chorley Letter 20th July) and wish to register my objections to some parts of it.

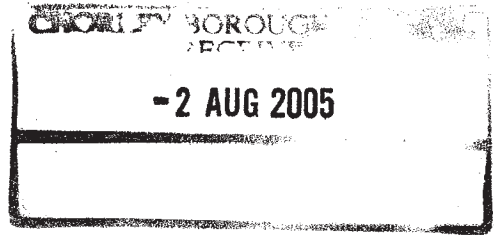
My main cause for concern is the extension on Friday and Saturday evenings and the sixty minutes of drinking up time with entertainment which will mean people exiting the premises at 02.00 AM.

This will create noise and disturbance to all residents in the vicinity which is bad enough at the moment. The main age group of the current customers is in the 18-25 bracket male & female, some of whom can't hold their drink and cause most of the arguments and fights.

Therefore, I propose that the closing time should be restricted to 24.00 hrs. every evening with a maximum of 30 minutes drinking up time.

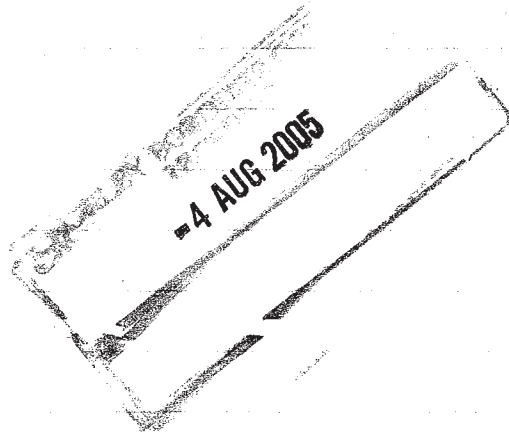
We are writing this letter with our concern over the hours, The Wheatsheaf Pub, 1 Spendmore Lane, Coppull, PR7 4N, are applying for.

We can not go to bed till after 11-30pm, because of noise, we can not open our bedroom windows in summer or winter because of the noise, and then after 12 to 1'clock the fighting, shouting, screaming, cars racing, the vandalism and that is only opening till 11'clock at night.

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing on behalf of my husband and myself concerning the application by the Wheatshed for longer licensing hours up to 1.00 a.m. and the fact that they would also like to be able to be allowed to put entertainment on within these hours. We are very much against this being passed as there are enough problems caused during the hours they are opened at present. On Saturday evenings music is being played until well after 11.30 pm and the same again on Sunday evenings with Karaoke going on after 11 pm. My husband gets up for work at 5.00 a.m. and because of this noise finds difficulty in sleeping. During the Summer months we can't even leave the windows open at night because of the disturbance.

We would also like to know if the council would be prepared to provide extra policing to cope with disturbances from drunks coming from the premises. We have already had cases of cars burnt out on the car park and neighbours have had fence panels damaged and damage to cars. We are not the only ones with these concerns, we have three young adolescents still at home with us ranging from 22-26 years and they are also against

the extra licensing hours. We all feel that it would be appropriate to allow them extended hours were it a town centre public house but not one that is within the centre of a number of houses. We ourselves have had problems in the past couple of years with youths actually fighting outside our front door and this was before the hours of 8.00 p.m. We are most concerned that this will happen more regularly and feel that we should not have this put upon us.

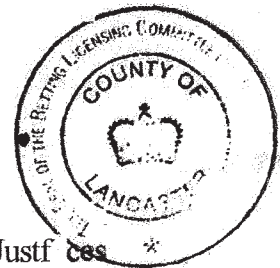
