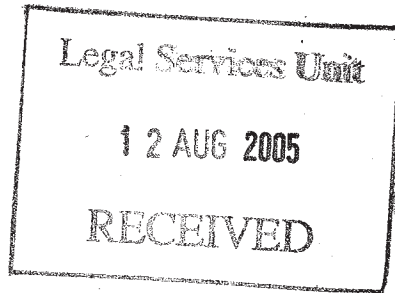

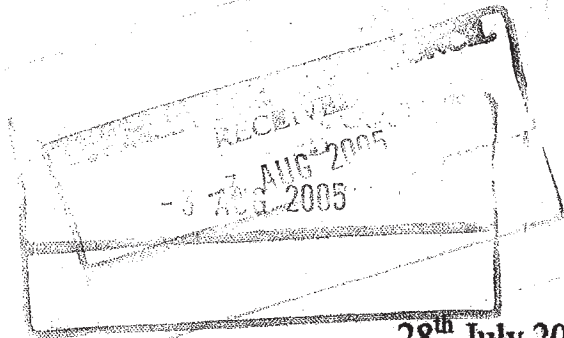
There are the following police representations to be made in respect of this application:-

1. The Police feel that 0100 hrs is too late for amplified music, because of the general surrounding area and amplified music or the like should finish prior to 0030, this would prevent Crime and Disorder, help Public Safety, prevent Public Nuisance and protect Children from Harm.
2. We have no objections to the terminal hour for alcohol, however we would wish to add a condition that no person member or otherwise is admitted to the club after 2330hrs.
3. We insist on a closing time and recommend 45 minutes following the last supply of alcohol.
4. We have no objection to recorded music until 0100 hrs, however the last half hour must be at a background volume to help encourage persons to exit the premises.

We strongly object to any increase of any kind to the existing licence of the above property. We already have to endure loud music being played at weekends until 11.30pm, often until midnight. As we live directly opposite the function room this means the noise is very loud and can be heard very clearly in our property, to the extent we can hear every lyric being sung! This would be completely unacceptable if it was happening on week nights too. In addition to the music there is also the issue of the clubs' patrons' noise when leaving the venue. The (usually alcohol fuelled) loud shouts and continued singing as they leave and the slamming of car doors and engines revving can mean it is after 1am before peace reigns. This is just about acceptable on a weekend evening but definitely not during the week when work and school mean we need to sleep.

In addition to the increase in noise would be the problem of parking. When there is a function on in the club or a bowling match on the green there is already inadequate car parking for customers, meaning they park on both sides of Spendmore Lane. Not only does this make access in and out of our and our neighbours properties difficult, but also creates a real hazard to traffic on Spendmore Lane, limiting visibility, causing obstructions and hindering pedestrians as cars are parked on the pavements.

The Conservative Club, although on the main road through Coppull is in a residential area, being surrounded on all four sides by family homes. We also have concerns about how any increase in opening times at the club would affect the value of our property in the future.

We have lived at our present address for 18 years and have tolerated the noise and parking problems with goodwill, justifying them as only occasional disruptions. Extending the licence would mean these problems would be aggravated to a point of being unbearable.

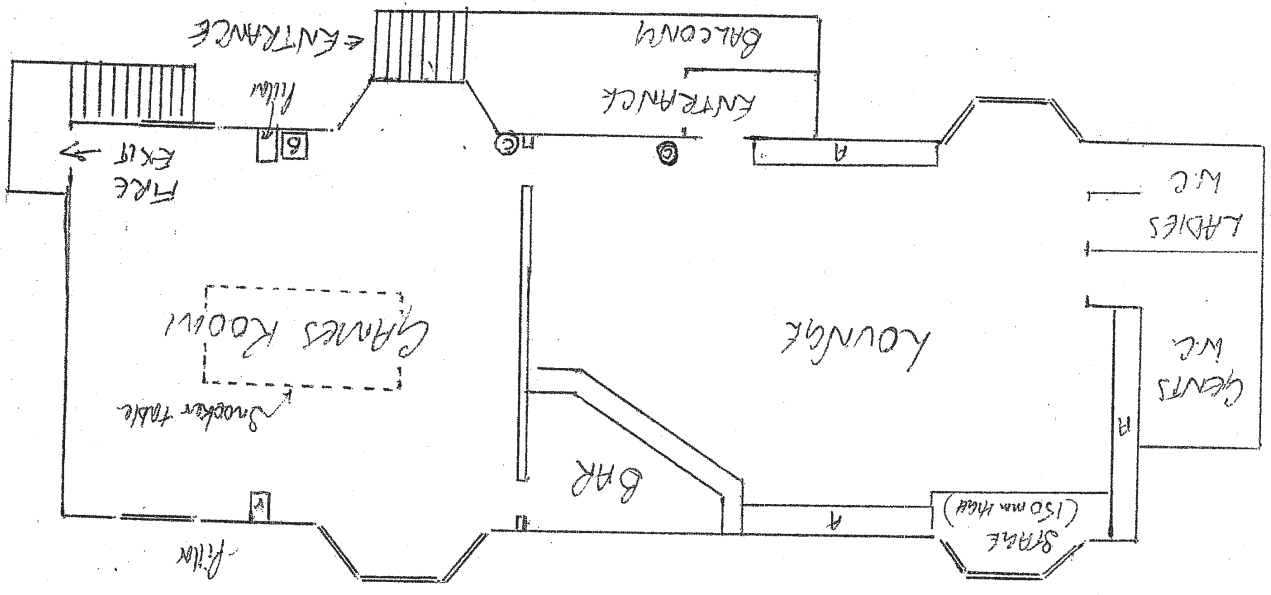
