Reasons for comment: - The Prevention of Public Nuisance

Comments: 8:57 AM on 20 Oct 2017 The Environmental Health Department has been currently investigating issues concerning noise from the establishment, in particular, loud amplified music. There are concerns that extended opening hours coupled with a possible intensification of the business could lead to statutory nuisance. It is recommended that the opening hours be revised and that adequate management of amplified music is undertaken i.e. the use of a sound limiting device. Especially after midnight, background noise sources would tend to decrease this coupled with residents preparing for bed or already being in bed has an increased possibility of nuisance. A sound limiting device is a beneficial tool in that it provides electronic control to limit the volume of music that, once pre-set, requires no further intervention by the site operator. The control of these two elements should go some way to ensuring that statutory nuisance does not arise at nearby residential dwellings.
