Reference License Application - Teresa Sharples - The Dog Inn, Whittle le Woods.

We would like to make Representation regarding the above application for Live Music and Extension of closing times.

The reasons we wish to object are as follows;

Our property is in close proximity to the public house and noise would adversely affect us, two recent examples of this have happened. Live music on Saturday nights, the rear door and windows of the public house were open and the noise was horrendous and unbearable and especially as it went on until well into the early hours and microphones were obviously being used.

We were aware that a new license application would be applied for and are now voicing our objections.

We would point out that our windows opposite the public house are double glazed and does not make any difference to the noise. The eaves of our roof are low and the bedrooms are on the side running parallel to the public house.

We would also like to mention that this area is all residential with houses opposite to the rear and our property alongside The Dog Inn, and that if this license is granted will encourage extra noise particularly at weekends and people gathering in front of the building especially on leaving the premises late at night.

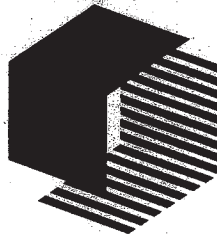

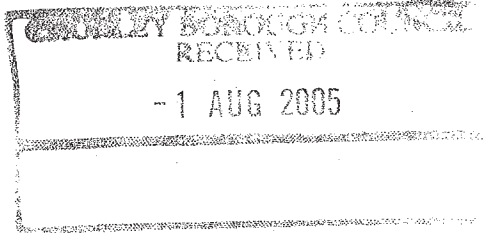

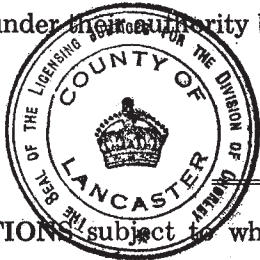
