We would like to offer a rejection to the extended hours of opening that have been applied for the DUKE of YORK public house in Whittle le Woods. We have been informed that an application has been received for the opening times to be changed to midnight during the week and 1.00 a.m. on a Friday and Saturday.

We live directly behind the Duke of York and in the past have spoken to the various landlords. We believe in direct contact but this does not seem to have any effect.

Our objections are based on the following:

- We already have an all day noise inconvenience from the Duke of York.
- At certain times we can hear noise above the level of our television within our cottage. We already endure "normal" pub noise from the Duke of York and are prepared to carry on with this within normal opening hours. We do not feel though that we should endure this beyond the current licensing hours.
- No effort is made to control this noise even when requested.
- The doors on the rear of the pub direct noise straight at our cottage.
- The doors are always propped open in the summer months.
- Little or no consideration is given to the local residents late at night and there are frequent disturbances around the pub, noisy disturbance is common place especially at weekends.
- Two Christmas's ago the pub was closed on new years eve due to a stabbing, if additional hours are allowed this would encourage further abuse.


We consider that the Duke of York is a village pub in a residential area and full consideration should be to the residents.

We would like to know if the application is to be approved who will be responsible for policing the extension hours.

Will the environmental agency or any other body be allowed to remove any authorisation if the noise and disturbances continue.

EMBEDDED BENEFITS

To answer the question "What existing licensable activities are authorised by your existing Licence(s)?" raised in part A3, we have adopted the second limb (b) of the definition given in paragraph 1 of Schedule 8 to the 2003 Act ("any other licensable activities which may be carried on ... by virtue of the existence of the licence").

For these premises, covered by a Justices' On-Licence, there are two such "embedded" benefits:

- 1. Playing of recorded music s.182 of the Licensing Act 1964 allows "...music and singing only which is provided solely by the reproduction of recorded sound" without the need for a Public Entertainment Licence; and
- 2. Provision of late night refreshment by virtue of the Late Night Refreshment Houses Act 1969. Section 1(2) exempts these premises from having to hold a Late Night Refreshment Licence from 10:00pm until 30 minutes after its permitted hours.

For these reasons, box f) recorded music and the box entitled Provision of Late Night Refreshment have been ticked as licensable activities which may be carried through the conversion process under "grandfather" rights.

If your Council has adopted the Private Places of Entertainment (Licensing) Act 1967, the provision of entertainment facilities for music and dancing promoted for private gain where the functions are private in nature is also a further licensable activity which should be carried forward as an embedded benefit through the conversion process.
