Decisions

Set out below is a summary of the decisions taken at the meeting of the Executive Cabinet held on Thursday, 9 December 2021. The wording used does not necessarily reflect the actual wording that will appear in the minutes.

5 Bengal Street Feasibility Update

- To acknowledge that a commitment to spend the awarded Brownfield Land Release funds needs to be made by the end of March 2022, therefore a report will be taken to Council on 25 January 2022 to approve these funds.
- 2. To acknowledge that the masterplan options and financial modelling for the development of the Bengal Street and National Grid sites are being updated. A report presenting the options will be taken to Informal Cabinet on 10 January 2022 and Executive Cabinet on 20 January 2022.

6 Approval for the Contract Award Procedure and Evaluation Criteria for ICT Hardware and Software

- 1. To approve the contract award procedure for a number of joint procurements with South Ribble Council outlined at Appendix 1 for software, hardware and support services.
- 2. To approve carrying out appropriate tender exercises via the councils' eprocurement portal (The Chest) or alternatively the use of existing procurement frameworks such as Crown Commercial Services or similar.
- 3. To approve the evaluation criteria of 80% cost and 20% quality.
- 4. To waive the requirement to use the Social Value Portal.
- 5. That the decision to award is delegated to the Executive Member of Resources.

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
