Notice of Motion

This council commits to signing up to the Race to Zero Campaign and to declare a commitment to achieving Carbon Net Zero by 2030. The United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change runs a global campaign called the Race to Zero which encourages businesses, cities, regions and investors to show leadership and support for a cleaner, healthier zero carbon recovery - one that prevents future threats, creates decent jobs and unlocks sustainable growth. The campaign requires stakeholders outside of national governments to sign a net zero pledge before planning the actions required, implementing them, and then regularly publishing their progress against the targets in their plan. This council supports this campaign and resolves that the Cabinet Member signs the Race to Zero pledge on behalf of Chorley Borough Council and publishes this council's plan on how it will achieve this goal and writes to the council's other key partner organisations to encourage them to also sign the pledge.
