The 2-hour session will be led by Graham Lowe, Online Safeguarding Advisor for Lancashire Safeguarding Children Board and will provide an overview of the current risk areas across the Online Safeguarding agenda including Information Privacy, Online Grooming, Bullying, Sexting, Radicalisation, Gaming and Social Media.
