## PROJECT GRIFFIN - COUNTER TERRORIST TRAINING

- Emergency Planning Officer attended trained by Greater Manchester Counter Terrorist Security Officers to deliver Project Griffin training package
- Emergency Planning Officer delivered Project Griffin to Corporate Management
  Team for them to decide if it should be cascaded further. Decision made to deliver modules 1- 4 to all frontline staff
- Emergency Planning Officer arranged training sessions for individual departments (no more than 10 staff per session) lasting approximately 1.30hrs
- Up to 1<sup>st</sup> Dec the following teams have received Project Griffin Training
  - Environmental Health (Pollution & Contaminated land) 5)
  - Environmental Enforcement (3)
  - Community Safety (1)
  - o Anti Social Behaviour (2)
  - o Countryside Rangers (4)
  - Leisure Team (5)
  - o Refuse & Recycling (50)
  - o Cleansing (30)
  - o Grounds Maintenance (20)
  - Building Control & Planning enforcement (10)
  - o Property Services (repairs) 12
- A further 5 sessions are planned in December(approx. 40 staff) and then any other outstanding teams will receive training in January
- A session will be planned for Parish Councils in the New Year.
- So far feedback from the sessions has been very positive with good discussions taking place throughout the sessions.
- The main modules covered have been.
  - What is Project Griffin
  - Current Threat profile
  - Suspicious Behaviour
  - o Bombs
